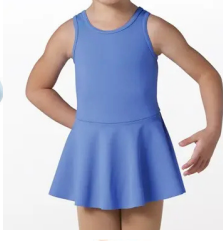


DRESS CODE 2025-2026



PRE-K BUTTERFLY GARDEN BALLET

OPTION 1: Traditionally Female

Any style, solid color leotard. No patterns or sparkles. Skirts are allowed if they are attached. Pink tights, **no underwear is to be worn under tights.** and pink ballet shoes. We can fit and order them through the studio or you can purchase any brand in pink. Please no tutus, unattached skirts, costumes, or leg warmers. Hair must be up, off the neck, and out of the face. (pony tail, pig tails, braids, bun). A fitted ballet sweater may be worn over leotard in winter. No tee shirts or sweatpants can be worn over dance clothes. Jewelry is not allowed except for small earrings. Please see examples of dress code friendly options to the left. Dance dresses can be ordered through the studio. Other dance wear can easily be purchased locally or on line.

PRE-K BUTTERFLY GARDEN BALLET

OPTION 2: Traditionally Male

Plain fitted white tee shirt or white leotard, black shorts, white socks, and black ballet shoes, any brand. If the dancer has long hair, it must be up, off the neck, and out of the face. (pony tail, pig tails, bun) Jewelry is not allowed except for small earrings. No tee shirts or sweatpants can be worn over dance clothes.



PRE-K DANCE COMBO AND STOMP, HOP, AND ROLL

(SAME DRESS CODE AND HAIR AS BUTTERFLY GARDEN, NO SKIRTS IN STOMP, HOP, AND ROLL

DANCE COMBO:

BALLET INTRO, LEVEL 1-4 OPTION 1: TRADITIONALLY FEMALE



For *INTRO*: Any solid color leotard, no skirts, pink tights, **no underwear is to be worn under tights.**

FOR LEVELS 1-4: Uniform leotards, color specific for each level, **MUST** be purchased at the studio. There are style options in each Level's color.

Pink tights and pink split sole ballet shoes, leather or canvas. A ballet sweater may be worn over leotard in winter. No baggy shirts or sweatpants allowed over dance clothes. No shorts and no leg warmers. Hair must be up in a proper bun consisting of a hair tie, a hairnet, and a minimum of 10 bobby pins! Jewelry is not allowed except for small earrings.

****Pointe shoes for pointe must be approved before ribbons are sewn on.**



BALLET INTRO, LEVEL 1-4 OPTION 2: TRADITIONALLY MALE

White tank leotard or fitted white tee shirt with black footed tights (not leggings) worn over. Level 2 & up must wear a dance belt. White socks and black split sole ballet shoes. No baggy shirts or sweatpants allowed over dance clothes. No leg warmers. Jewelry is not allowed except for small earrings. If the dancer has long hair, it must be up in a proper bun consisting of a hair tie, a hairnet, and a minimum of 10 bobby pins!

TEEN THEATRE DANCE

SHOWTIME LEVELS PRE-K, INTRO, 1-4 INCLUDING TEAMS

Any style solid color leotard, dance/exercise tops, leggings, tights, booty shorts. (All in solid colors, no patterns.) There can be NO clothes worn over dance clothes. No baggy teeshirts, sweatshirts, or sweatpants will be allowed in class. Boys should wear athletic pants, joggers, or shorts, no baggy sweats. Hair pulled neatly back off the neck and out of face (pony tail, braids, or bun) Slip on Jazz shoes as pictured to the left.

NEW THIS SEASON: ALL JAZZ SHOES MUST BE ORDERED THROUGH THE STUDIO. CLASS SHOES ARE THE SAME SHOES THAT WILL BE WORN FOR THE RECITAL. SHOES FROM LAST SEASON CAN BE WORN TO CLASS UNTIL THEY ARE TOO SMALL. THE PROPER COLORS WILL NEED TO BE PURCHASED FOR THE SPRING.

Jewelry is not allowed except for small earrings. Please see examples of dress code friendly options to the left.

TAP INTRO, 1-4

Same as Jazz Dresscode. Please ensure we can see your feet, jazz pants must be ankle length.

Shoes: Black oxford lace up tap shoes.
Level 3/4 can wear black heeled taps

Black Hip Hop sneakers for all levels. (PK students do not need these sneakers) MUST be ordered through FNC.



HIP HOP: INTRO, LEVELS 1-4

Any style solid color leotard, dance/exercise tops, leggings, tights, booty shorts. (All in solid colors, no patterns.) There can be NO clothes worn over dance clothes. No baggy teeshirts, sweatshirts, or sweatpants will be allowed in class. Hair pulled neatly back off the neck and out of face (pony tail, braids, or bun).

Black canvas Hip Hop sneakers must be purchased through FNC. No street shoes allowed in the studios. Jewelry is not allowed except for small earrings. Please see examples of dress code friendly options to the left.

ACRO: ALL LEVELS

Any style solid color leotard, dance/exercise tops, leggings, tights, booty shorts. (All in solid colors, no patterns.) There can be NO clothes worn over dance clothes. No baggy teeshirts, sweatshirts, or sweatpants will be allowed in class. Hair pulled neatly back off the neck and out of face (pony tail, braids, or bun) **BARE FEET ONLY!** No socks or shoes allowed in Acro. Jewelry is not allowed except for small earrings. Please see examples of dress code friendly options to the right.
